Meeting called to order by Dave Chervenak at 7:09 via teleconference (Zoom) per KRS 61.840.

Minutes from March were discussed. No corrections Dwight motioned and Gail seconded. Minutes approved.

Treasurer's report for April was read and approved. Gail motioned and Dwight seconded.

- Treasurer noted that a letter was sent to her from a resident (after 30 days) to explain why taxes were delinquent and requesting the fee be waived. - Gail reported that the leak is marked for repair by the water company.
- Gail will keep calling and may call Councilwoman McCraney.

New Business

- Board discussed procedure- Dave and Dwight will do further research and report back to the council.
