Meeting called to order by Paul Muth at 7:02 pm.

Paul asked residents to voice their concerns prior to routine business details.

A resident brought forth concerns of favoritism shown to a resident on Brentmoor and the same resident running a business from their home.

Another resident brought concerns about building permits.

Another resident brought concerns about the MSD easement on Claremoor being cleared and a bus being parked in city limits.

## Old Business

- Barbara spoke to Cathy Cash and the full amount to be paid to LG&E is approved.
- One light on Brentmoor was not replaced with the LED. Paul will call to discuss.
- Bids were received for the trimming of the bushes and mulch to be laid at the front entrance. We will proceed with more bids and look for landscaping that will be easy to maintain.
- The bid to fix the sidewalks was received and Paul motioned to move forward to have the work done. Jessie seconded.
- Jason will reach out to Spectrum again to discuss the repair to the section of sidewalk that was cut in the front entrance.
- Resident 1721 Bentmoor is having a company come to cut the overgrowth on the utility pole in their yard.
- Jamie will resend the letter created to address the MSD drainage easement on Claremoor.

## New Business

- Brentmoor will be delayed in opening due to work being done late in the day.
- A resident brought to the board's attention that a light pole was hit by a senior citizen bus and needs to be repaired.
- A resident brought to the board's attention that Louisville Water Co. left sawhorses in front of his home and has never come to pick them up.
- Barbara called the League of Cities to discuss changing how we ask for bids and was advised that by law all bids have to be advertised in major paper, sealed and mailed to the City of Moorland PO Box. Commissioners can ask companies that do not look at paper to mail official bids.
- Certified letters to two residents with overgrowth, one resident with damaged garage and overgrowth and one resident that is fined for driving on the sealcoating when the road was closed will be sent.

Paul motioned to adjourn the meeting. Jessie seconded.
