**Business**

- Barbara is working with the state to move funds into an investment account.

- Tony provided an estimate for the 2024/25 winter season. The board agreed that we need to secure estimates in the fall. Paul motioned to accept the bid and Jason seconded. Paul will discuss the two jobs that have not been completed with Tony that was brought forth during discussion.
- The board discussed the issue of having contracts in hand before the 31st for use of the ARS funds, so we don't lose them. Baraba will contact the League of Cities to make sure we handle everything correctly. Hall's paving was discussed for work and the seal coating would need to happen in the summer of 2025. The seal coating project would use all of the ARS funds and the rest would come out of the municipal aid road fund.
- The commissioners discussed using Wordpress vs Wix for the creation of the new website. Paul motioned to approve up to \$5k for the creation of the website, all motioned to agree and Barbara will get a contract in writing.
- Louisville Water Company repaired the concrete around the fire hydrant. No response for the efforts to have them repair the section at the entrance to the neighborhood.
- Paul swore in as commissioners Angela, Jason, and Kevin for 2 year positions.

Paul motioned to adjourn the meeting and Jason seconded. Meeting adjourned at 7:42 PM
