Old Business

Rumpke

- Board discussed Rumpke adding more recycling

Entrance Lawn Care

- Paul Muth offered to take care of lawn maintenance for free.
- Barbara reported that the League of Cities says it is fine with proof of insurance. Barbara will check with Moorland's city insurance to confirm the amount needed

Entrance Signs

- Board discussed entrance signs, pulling out old signs, and purchasing new ones.
- It was noted that the road work should be beginning soon and signs may have to be moved then. Board discussed installing signs further back so as not to interfere with the road work.
- Clerk will invite previous council member, Morgan Herndon, to the next meeting to share the road expansion plans and bring further insight to the discussion.

New Business

Ordinance Violation

- Board discussed cars parked in yards and on the street without two wheels in the grass.
- Residents should only park on the street with two wheels in the grass and may NOT park their cars in their yards.

Salting the roads

- With an ice storm expected for next week, board discussed salting the roads. A decision will be made closer to the day based on weather conditions.
