Old Business

Speed Humps and Reflector Sticks

- Board discussed when to put in reflector sticks for speed humps and decided that if snow is covering the speed humps (especially if snow removal is called in), reflector sticks will be installed.

Entrance Lawn Care

- Paul Muth offered to take care of lawn maintenance for free.
- Board discussed pros (saving money) and cons (possible conflict of interests).
- Barbara will check with the League of Cities to see if it is legal for Paul to care for entrance lawn maintenance for free.

Street Lights

- Board discussed replacing street light bulbs with LED bulbs. Paul will research the cost and benefits

New Business

Ordinance Violation

- Board discussed “Buy Your House Cheap” sign in the neighborhood. Paul will take down the sign as it is in violation of a city ordinance to put up advertising signs.

Advertising on Website

- Kevin brainstormed ways of adding revenue to the city- noting that local ads could be placed on Moorland’s website.
- Board discussed legality, cost vs benefit, and pros and cons. Board will consider the idea and Kevin may look into details.

Community Building

- Board discussed various community building opportunities within Moorland. E.g. Food trucks, pot lucks, annual yard sale, a meet your commissioners opportunity. Board will continue to discuss and possibly plan something for the Spring or Summer.

Newsletter/Yard Sale

- Board discussed sending out the annual newsletter in April or May and will begin advertising the yard sale to be held in June.
