- Bids were received for the trimming of the bushes and mulch to be laid at the front entrance. We will table the discussion for another month.
- The contract to renew the Rumpke Sanitation was signed.
- Contacted the company that first did the sidewalk shaving and they told the city that there was supposed to be a phase two that wasn't completed. They already had the schematics and will let us know what the second phase will cost.

New Business

- The new budget was passed. Angela motioned and Jasn seconded.
- Jason is calling Spectrum about the sidewalk at the front entrance that has not been repaired.
- The new City Ordinance for the increase in earnings for the board was signed.
- A letter is being sent to an owner on Farnham to have a very damaged tree cut from falling onto the power lines.
- A letter is to be sent to 1719 and 1721 Brentmoor about an electrical pole that could not be reached by LG&E per the honeysuckle obstruction.
- Jamie will draft a letter to new residents to welcome them to the neighborhood and also make them aware of some top ordinances in the City of Moorland.
