Meeting called to order by Dave Chervenak at 7:06

Dave called meeting to order at 7:06 PM

Minutes from May were discussed. No corrections Dwight motioned and Gail seconded. Minutes approved.

Treasurer's report for June was read and approved. Gail motioned and Dwight seconded.

- Treasurer noted that there were 6 tax delinquencies; 3 paid. 1809 Claremoor delinquent on '19 and '20- lien filed. 1911 Claremoor 2020 delinquent, 9209 Earlham- not paid since 2017. Letter sent saying trash could not be picked up. Barbara called to ask her to pay by 6/1, has not paid as of this meeting. Lien already filed.

Old Business

Signs

- Board discussed a suggestion to install “No Outlet” signs on dead-end streets.

Landscaping

- Board discussed that landscaper needs to be contacted regarding broken limbs at entrance

Letters to Residents

- 9333 LaGrange- apartments. Received a call complaining about garbage being left out. Danielle to send a letter
- 1901 Ashmoor- Dave sent Danielle a draft of the letter giving resident 45 days from the date of letter to correct the issue.
- 1607 Ashmoor- Letter will need to be sent to resident to ask them to clean the drain in the front of the yard to prevent flooding.

New Business

Resident concerns

- Board discussed 1907 Brentmoor- couch outside, garbage everywhere, gutters not cleaned, brush pile left, car parked in front of mailbox, talked to property owner, but did not help and didn't relay information to tenants. Danielle to send letter requesting them to clean up.

Waste Contract

- Board noted that the price of the dumpster is increasing significantly; cans at entrance are still emptied only intermittently; total increase is \$300/month for everything; renew open up for bids? Board discussed pros and cons and decided to renew, but Dave will request a dumpster to equal 4 cans.
- Dwight will call the League of Cities about nursery and possible tax on road usage.

Gail motioned to adjourn the meeting. Dwight seconded.
