Meeting called to order by Paul Muth at 7:05 pm

Minutes from February were approved. Angela Muth made a motion to accept last month's minutes. Kevin Gittings seconded.

The Treasurer's report for March was read and approved. Checks were signed

Several of the speed hump markers are missing. Paul removed the rest of them after snow plowing was finished.

Morgan Herndon, former commissioner, was invited to attend the meeting and discuss the project at the entrance to the subdivision. He brought several plans to share with the Board. There is no definite start date. Ms. McCraney said she would try to find out a time frame from someone at the State. Thanks to Morgan for coming and explaining the plans.

A resident wondered why we had to have garbage cans at the entrance. It was explained that there is a lot of foot traffic and it keeps the trash from being all over the streets and sidewalks. Rumpke empties them.

The subject of replacing the City of Moorland Entrance signs was discussed again. It was agreed by the Board that we would place an ad in the CJ soliciting bids. A maximum of \$12,000 was set that would include installation. Paul will look for paperwork that David gave to him which had information gathered before.

Angela passed out information regarding LED lights to replace what is now used in the street lights.

Paul will contact LGE to inquire about lighting around the trees at the entrance.

Barbara passed out the paperwork received from the County regarding filing deadlines and fees for Mayor and Commissioner. It will be discussed next month since the filing deadline is June 7th, 2022.
