### Speed Humps and Reflector Sticks

- Board discussed adding reflector sticks to speed humps to inform drivers of an upcoming speed hump after dark/in the snow.
- Angela presented board with reflector sticks that can be bought on Amazon. Board gave consent to purchase the reflector sticks due to the low price and potential benefits.
- Reflector sticks will be used if snow is covering the speed humps (1 on each side of incline)
- Board discussed speed hump specifications that came from the state. Barbara will look up the company that installed them and ask previous mayor for the specifications.

### Entrance sign

- Board discussed taking down the old sign
- Board discussed waiting to install a new sign until roadwork is completed.
- Bored member noted that a resident offered to take down the old sign and replace it. Board stated that the resident should not do this as this is a Board decision.
