Meeting called to order by Paul Muth at 6:56 pm.

Minutes from October were approved by Paul and Angela seconded.

The Treasurer's report for October was read and approved. Paul motioned and Angela seconded.

- A homeowner paid 2023 taxes and Barbara recently received a check from the person's mortgage company for the same year. A check will be issued and mailed for refund.
- A check for \$92.77 will be issued to a homeowner who has homestead exemption.
- Barabra researched the ARS fund and confirmed that the money has to be committed by the end of 2024. A check would not have to be issued by that time but a signed contract would have to be in place.

- The commissioners discussed the information gathered on putting funds into an investment account. The funds would have to stay in Kentucky. Paul put forth that 100k be put into an interest bearing account if money can be pulled out without penalty. All commissioners voted to approve.

### **Business**

- Barbara contacted a friend that creates websites and discussed Wix. A website that has a monthly subscription. Kevin brought forth that it is difficult for an average person to utilize. Barbara will get a quote for the cost of the website to be created and Kevin and Jamie will meet with the web designer to discuss options and details of design.
- The commissioners discussed the camera issue. Kevin suggested talking to all neighbors near the cameras. He stated that the camera would have an SD card that would be accessed directly or by having a subscription online. Discussed that the camera would not be directed at any homes but primarily on the road leading to and away from Bowen. Moorland still needs another quote on signs that would need to be posted. Kevin will reach out to get a price for the subscription to access camera data. Paul will reach out to Bowen to discuss that no point person has been at the gate, that was previously agreed upon.
- Jason did not fill out the paperwork for being elected a commissioner and therefore will be unseated after the election. Discussed re swearing him in the position again at next meeting. Tammy was asked to join as a commissioner and she will think about it.
- Kevin has been working on two open LWC cases.

Paul motioned to adjourn the meeting and Kevin seconded. Meeting adjourned at 7:34 PM
