Treasurer's report for November was read.

Tyler motioned to accept the treasurer's report, Morgan seconded, the report was approved.

- Treasurer noted that municipal aid is funded from gas sales and can only be used for roads, this is not part of the municipal tax

- Treasurer noted that the 2020 taxes were mailed as of the end of last week. Anyone who didn't receive a bill and thinks they should have should call Barbara.

- Financial statement has been filed
- Delinquent tax on resident- will send a letter and then file a lien if necessary.

Old Business

Premium Tax

- John Hord joined to answer questions regarding the premium tax
- It was noted that Metro Louisville has put this tax on Moorland residents
- Mayor noted that there was only a state tax listed on his premium. No local tax.
- Some insurance companies do not pass the tax on to residents
- J.Hord noted that nothing says incorporated cities in the county are excluded from the tax and that unless the county specifically excludes incorporated areas, these parts will be taxed. J. Hord explained that software can determine for sure. He will also confirm with the chief examiner.
- Mayor will check Jefferson County ordinances to see if excludes incorporated areas.
- Residents can check their insurance premiums by looking at the declaration page and finding the municipal tax (should be around 5%).

New Business

Eco Tech Waste Company

- This company pursued an open records request for city information
- Eco Tech plans to bid for Moorland's waste management.
