Meeting called to order by Dave Chervenak at 7:01

Dave called meeting to order at 7:01 PM

Discussion with Brent Hagan, Mayor of Lyndon

Mayor of Lyndon and board of Moorland discussed merger/transfer of the city of Moorland to Lyndon.

- It was noted that if no commissioners step up, the city would dissolve after 1 year and be turned over to Metro Louisville with higher taxes and limited services
- If the city merges with Lyndon there would be increased services such as local police to patrol the city, Lyndon public works (including snow removal), etc

- Funds from Moorland would go to the general fund, but can negotiate as part of merger any special projects for Moorland (entrance sign, roads, etc).
- Would need 51% of residents (not homeowners) over the age of 18 and registered to vote (1 member from each household); with the exception of the apartments which would need the owner's vote.
- Can be completed by ballot at a general election or door to door survey.

City Council Positions

The board noted that there are 3 positions open on the city council- Mayor and 2 commissioners. Interested persons' names were written down and drawn at random from a box. Paul Muth, Angela Muth, and Mayna DiChiara's names were selected. They were then sworn in by Mayor Dave Chernevak. Interested persons' names for mayor were placed in a box and drawn at random. Paul Muth was selected mayor.

Regular Business

Minutes from August were discussed. No corrections Gail motioned and Dwight seconded. Minutes approved.

Treasurer's report for September was read and approved. Mayna motioned and Gail seconded.

- Checks were signed
- Noted that tax rate needs to be set for 2021. Currently \$ 0.22 per 100 (\$55,000 a year).

Old Business

Lawn Care

- Paul Muth asked if the entrance could be mowed by him for free. Board members noted that it would be allowed, but noted the extent of the lawn care provided by the paid service including snow removal, tree trimming, and laying mulch.

Saftico

- Sign in the neighborhood needs to be replaced. Angela Muth will call Saftico to replace.

Tax Rate

- Rate of \$0.20 per 100 was discussed
- Gail motioned, Angela and Mayna seconded, and .20 tax rate passed.
- Will need to be published in the Courier Journal once the ordinance is passed

Annexation
