Minutes from August were read. Tyler motioned to accept. Morgan seconded. Minutes accepted.

Treasurer's report for September was read.

- Board had a question about LG&E payment (was not among checks that needed signatures)- Tyler volunteered to email treasurer

Morgan motioned to accept the treasurer's report, Dwight seconded, the report was approved.

Old Business

Beautification

Entrance:

- Board discussed placement of new signage- between trash cans
- Tyler noted that initial cost estimate is \$10,000 for 2 signs at entrance (high cost due to stonework)
- Dave suggested that council talk to city of Meadowvale for information about their signs
- Board discussed cost of signs vs roads noting that city needs to have enough money for paving
- Board discussed possibly installing 1 sign at a time to spread the cost (starting with the sign on the right-hand side when entering the city)
- Tyler noted that \$10,000 included lighting the signs
- Board decided to wait to talk with treasurer next month to create specific budget and time-line.
- Board will research styles and designs to bring to next meeting.

Ordinance Review

- Mayor noted that cost of publishing amended ordinances in full in the local newspaper is very expensive. Mayor noted that board may not need to update many ordinances as Linda Magruder went through them all and typed them up in full. Review of ordinances needs to be completed every 5 years.
- Board noted that ordinance 120.2 section 5 should be changed from \$2.00 to \$10.00 to comply with state law.
- Board discussed amending ordinance and adding section of 120. 2 Attendance
- 120.1 reviewing duties of board
- Adding day, time, and location of Lyndon
- Dave noted that he will write up changes for vote next month.
